Cunha in the middle of the South Atlantic Ocean. Some 260 Tristanians live here, all British citizens as the island is a UK Territory, in the island's only community of Edinburgh-of-the-Seven-Seas. There's no way to fly here – you have to take a boat for at least a week from Cape Town (and then a week back).

Tristanians are among the world's most special people. Since the island was first settled in 1810, there has never been a single murder, abortion, or divorce among them. They are at peace with themselves, unfailingly cheerful, hospitable, and contented. If you are lucky enough to reach here, you may not want to ever leave.
