WHEN WILL PEOPLE FINALLY SEE THE OBVIOUS?

One of the most

memorable lines from the 1995 movie "The Usual Suspects" is this: "The greatest trick the devil ever pulled was convincing the world he did not exist."

With just a little tweak, this statement could be applied to the last presidential election: "*The greatest trick the Democrats ever pulled was convincing the voters they did not steal the 2020 election.*"

Consider the number of things the Left has been willing to lie to the American people about in recent years. The short list includes:
